The Seven Virtues (Seven Spirits)

1	<i>the spirit of the Lord</i> , the nature of Jesus
2	<i>the spirit of wisdom</i> , the ability to make the right decision
3	<i>the spirit of understanding</i> , the ability to understand everything
4	<i>the spirit of counsel</i> , the ability to give sound advice
5	<i>the spirit of might</i> , the power to do what God wants
6	<i>the spirit of knowledge</i> , the ability to know beyond human comprehension
7	<i>the spirit of the fear of the Lord</i> , the ability to respect God's will

1	Sin is the transgression of the <i>Law</i>; breaking God's rules (1 John 3:4)
2	Sin is knowing to do good but not doing it (James 4:17)
3	Sin is anything that is not of <i>faith</i>; not trusting in God (Romans 14:23)
4	Sin is all <i>unrighteousness</i>; wickedness (1 John 5:17)
5	Sin is a disease of the soul; the inner part of man that lives forever (Psalm 41:4)

10 Periods of Persecution known by their Roman Emperors

(dates are approximate)

1	Nero (64–68 a.d.)—burned Rome and blamed Christians; crucified and threw Christians into pits with wild animals; executed Paul and possibly Peter
2	Domitian (90–96 a.d.)—killed thousands in Rome; banished John to the Isle of Patmos
3	Trajan (104–117 a.d.)—outlawed Christianity; burned Ignatius at the stake
4	Marcus Aurelius (161–180 a.d.)—tortured and beheaded Christians
5	Severus (200–211 a.d.)—burned, crucified, and beheaded Christians
6	Maximinus (235–237 a.d.)—executed Christians
7	Decius (250–253 a.d.)—tried to wipe out Christianity and executed those he could find
8	Valerian (257–260 a.d.)—tried to wipe out Christianity; executed the Bishop of Carthage
9	Aurelian (270–275 a.d.)—persecuted Christians any way he could
10	Diocletian (303–312 a.d.)—burned the Scriptures

China (Mao's Cultural Revolution, 1966–76)	20 million
U.S.S.R. (Stalin's reign of terror, 1933–45)	20 million
Europe (the Holocaust, 1933–45)	11 million
Pakistan (reprisals against Bengalis, 9 months in 1971)	3 million
Cambodia (the Khmer Rouge killing fields, 1975–79)	1.6 million
Rwanda (Tutsis, 3 months in 1994)	1 million
Indonesia (killings of Communists and Chinese, 1965–66)	500,000
Bosnia (ethnic cleansing, 1992–94)	200,000 9-26

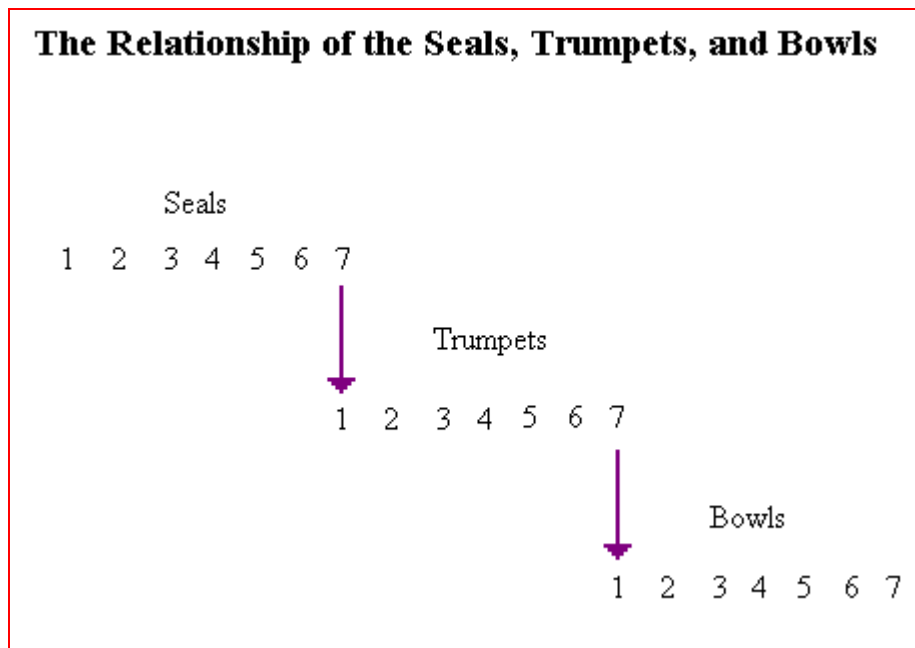

Seal 3—Judgment	Black horse, scales of economic collapse & famine
Seal 4—Judgment	Pale horse, death
Seal 5—Judgment	Many believers die
Seal 6—Judgment	Earthquake
Seal 7—Judgment	(Starts the Seven Trumpet Judgments)

Trumpet 1–Judgment	1/3 of trees and grass will burn up
Trumpet 2–Judgment	1/3 of sea will become blood
Trumpet 3–Judgment	1/3 of fresh water will be polluted
Trumpet 4–Judgment (woe)	1/3 of sunlight and moonlight will be diminished
Trumpet 5–Judgment (woe)	a plague of demon locusts will infest the land
Trumpet 6–Judgment (woe)	war will ravage the nations
Trumpet 7–Seven Bowl Judgments (woe)	(Starts the Seven Bowl Judgments)

Seven Bowl Judgments and Results

Bowl 1—Judgment	100 pound hail, fire, and blood hurled to earth; 1/3 of trees and grass will burn up
Bowl 2—Judgment	Burning mountain hurled into sea; 1/3 of seas will become polluted with blood, fish killed, ships sunk
Bowl 3—Judgment	Blazing object fall to earth; 1/3 of fresh water polluted
Bowl 4—Judgment	Heavenly bodies struck; 1/3 of sun, moon, and stars darkened
Bowl 5—Judgment	Abyss opened; A plague of demon-possessed locusts released, infesting the land
Bowl 6—Judgment	Four angels released at Euphrates; war will ravage the nations, 1/3 of mankind killed
Bowl 7—Judgment End of Tribulation	(Marks the End of the Tribulation Period)

The First Resurrection

Phase 1:	the resurrection of <i>Christ</i> and some <i>Old Testament Saints</i>
Phase 2:	the resurrection of the <i>Church</i> at the Rapture
Phase 3:	the resurrection of the <i>two witnesses</i>
Phase 4:	the resurrection of the <i>Tribulation Saints</i> and the remainder of the <i>Old Testament Saints</i> (Matthew 27:52-53; Daniel 12:1-3) at the end of the Tribulation Period

Six Things About Those Who Will Have A Part In The First Resurrection

- 1 *Blessed*—they will be happy in their eternal state!
- 2 *Holy*—they will be separated or identified as God's special people!
- 3 *Priests*—they will minister to, and serve in the presence of God!
- 4 *Reign*—they will be both a royal and a political priesthood (Revelation 5:10, 1 Peter 2:9)!
- 5 *A thousand years*—the length of their earthly reign with Jesus!
- 6 *The **second death** has no power over them*—they will never suffer the consequences of their sin by being cast into the **Lake of Fire** (Revelation 19:20; 20:10) because they have been redeemed!
